Conclusions & Key messages

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Key messages (1/2)

- EDEXIM was closed down on Friday 22 August
- There is no system available between 22 August and 2 September; during this time, ECHA is processing all notifications and performing the final steps of data migration to ePIC
- ePIC will go live on 2 September and will be <u>the</u> only processing system for all PIC tasks
- EDEXIM will be available in read-only mode until 30 November with your old credentials (if you wish to verify the migrated data)
