

# What is the Forum?

The Forum is an ECHA body which coordinates a network of authorities responsible for the enforcement of the REACH and CLP Regulations in the EU, Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein.

# Who is in the Forum?

One member from each EU Member State and Norway, Iceland and Liechtenstein. The Forum Chair and two Vice-Chairs are elected by the Forum from among its members.

## What is the Forum doing?

- Spreading good practice on REACH and CLP enforcement
- Coordinating enforcement projects
- Developing enforcement strategies
- Developing methods and tools for inspectors
- Facilitating communication between inspectors
- Advising on the enforceability of the restrictions on manufacture, placing on the market and use of chemicals
- Advising on other issues related to the enforceability of the REACH and CLP Regulations

## How does the Forum work?

- The Forum establishes its own Work Programme
- Working Groups elaborate solutions to enforcement challenges
- Two or three plenary meetings per year take decisions

The Forum coordinates harmonised enforcement projects which are implemented in the Member States.
