

National Expert in professional training (NEPT); ref.: ECHA/SNE/2019/001

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The NEPT will work in one of the Units in Directorate Hazard Assessment in charge of dossier and substance evaluation. The main tasks of NEPT will be one of the following:

- Contributing to the (eco)toxicological assessment of groups of structurally similar substances under the integrated regulatory strategy, to decide on the need for regulatory risk management or the generation of further information;
- Assessing read-across and categories applied by registrants under dossier evaluation;
- Supporting Member States to assess and/or apply read-across and categories approaches under substance evaluation;
- Contributing to the implementation of the new approach to perform an integrated substance evaluation and compliance check (combo approach) by a close collaboration between ECHA and the evaluating Member State;
- Contributing to the assessment of reproductive toxicity information requirements and in particular the design of the extended one reproductive toxicity study.

REQUIREMENTS:

Education: Successful completion of a full course of university studies attested by a scientific degree in chemistry, engineering or (eco)toxicology where the normal duration of university education is three (3) or more years.

Experience:

- At least three (3) years of professional experience in chemicals risk assessment and/or management
