Key Recommendations

- A new WG "Prioritisation" is set up with a view to starting the process of agreeing the scope for REF IV in 2014
- The new cycle of REF projects commences in 2014 as per the following slide.
- There is 1 REF project per year
- o That REF III is prolonged in 2014
 - To gather more experience with enforcement of imported substances and cooperation with customs
 - To highlight the importance of checking compliance with registration

 - Manual / questionnaire
 - Reporting tools
 - Final report
