Introductory Remarks

- Rules of Procedure of the Forum: "The Forum shall establish a work programme in order to plan the execution of its tasks." [Article 2(4)]
- The second Multi-Annual Work Programme 2011-2013 of Forum is currently in force (published on ECHA web site)
- The Work Programme 2011-2013 addresses the activities of the second term of the Forum
- As a body of ECHA, Forum is also covered in the Multi-Annual Work Programmes of ECHA



The Forum Work Programme 2011-2013

- Addressing the Forum activities in REACH and in CLP in the light of Forum tasks defined in Article 77(4) of REACH
- <u>Section 1:</u> tasks covered by 15 individual work packages for three sectoral fields
 - Forum coordinated enforcement projects (e.g. "REF-1", "REF-2", "REF-3" with customs)
 - Enforcement of REACH and CLP (e.g. access to REACH-IT, information exchange, interlinks)
 - Forum organisational and general administrative issues (e.g. up-date of Work Programme, communication strategy)



The Forum Work Programme 2011-2013

• <u>Section 2:</u> detailed "Activity Plans" for each of the 15 work packages

- For each work package the priority level, the objectives and envisaged output is explained
- Work packages are typically covered by working groups of the Forum (currently 9 working groups operational)



Work Packages

- Reach-en-Force 1 (REF1): coordinated enforcement project on registration, pre-registration and SDS (*)
- Reach-en-Force 2 (REF2): coordinated enforcement project on obligations of downstream users formulators of mixtures (*)
- Reach-en-Force 3 (REF3): coordinated enforcement project with customs on registration obligations of manufacturers, importers and only representatives (*)
- Strategies for REACH and CLP enforcement
- Interlinks between ECHA, Competent Authorities and enforcement authorities (*)



Work Packages

- Access to information from REACH-IT needed by enforcement authorities (*)
- Development of an electronic information exchange system (*)
- Guidance on enforcement methods and enforcement practise (*)
- Training programme for inspectors, including exchange of inspectors and joint inspections (*)
- Co-operation with the customs authorities (*)
- Penalties for non compliance overview
