Professional experience

Since 2018, Ms. Kristīne Kazerovska is working at the Environmental Protection Department of the Ministry of Environmental Protection and Regional Development in Latvia (MEPRD) and currently she is the Deputy director of the Environmental Protection Department of the MEPRD. The department covers a range of topics on environmental protection, including chemicals management - REACH, CLP, Biocides PIC, POP, Mercury regulation and global environmental management issues, such as Stockholm Convention, Rotterdam Convention and Minamata Convention on mercury.

Prior to being employed at the MEPRD, she was Head of Public Health Surveillance and Control Department at the Health Inspection of the Republic of Latvia, and tasks of this department also included the enforcement of REACH, CLP, Biocides, Detergents and Cosmetics regulation. She also has experience as ECHA Forum member.
