Antimony Trioxide (ATO)

- ☐ EU Risk Assessment: 2000-2008
 - human tox and environmental studies
 - cost shared → i2a
- ☐ REACH registration: 2010
 - most data from EU Risk Assessment (i2a)







Italian Trader





- disagreement to contribute retroactively to EU RA data
- trader did not initiate 'cost sharing dispute'
- □ separately registered ATO
 - OSOR violation
 - Box ticking' poor quality, old data, errors
 - Some critical endpoints from i2a studies data ownership violation (disseminated data from EU web sites)
- No corrective actions to date



Status

- ☐ GENERAL
 - not unique
 - new TCC can no longer happen
- ☐ ATO / i2a members



- competitive disadvantage = no constructive message
- 2018 registrants?
- additional data generation post registration: more 'free riders'?





Seeking Help From ECHA / COM

- ☐ To drive (also retroactively) level playing field and fair-play
 - Compliance Checks on registrations that may violate OSOR
 - No data no market
- ☐ To drive fair data cost sharing among all who benefit
