#### The SCEDs:

- Are sets of more realistic exposure determinants to be used as "information input" in a consumer exposure assessment
- Document typical conditions of use of consumer products, expressed in a form that can be fed into the commonly applied exposure assessment tools (e.g. quantity of product used, frequency of use, place of use...).
- Initially foreseen for use under ECETOC TRA and Chesar, but also possible to use the SCED information in other REACH consumer models (such as CONSEXPO).

- Workshop with Member States in October 2013
- Template + Guidance published in April 2014
- SCEDs factsheets published by Concawe and A.I.S.E./FEA
- Other sectors developing SCEDs: CEPE, FEICA and possibly EFCC

## Revision of "Guidance on IR&CSA – Chapter R.15 Consumer exposure estimation"....

- Sectors to assess impact of new approach proposed for infrequent uses
- Revision/Publication of SCEDs pending no exact planning possible for the time being
