

- ECHA is confident about migration of SPERC input files from Chesar 2 to Chesar 3




SPERC Adaptation in CHESAR Discussion - Results



- Identifier section: More consistency with in Best Practice Format (e.g. field names, freetext field for scope, SPERC code).
- Conditions of use section: Standardization Consensus
 - is desirable
 - is not feasible at present, has to be postponed.
- Sub-SPERCs: add fields, change naming of fields.
- Fields with mandatory input: Have been agreed upon. Flexibility for remaining fields.



Feedback from Industry

- Evaluations to date find the format more or less ok
- Several suggestions for making the factsheet format more granular are discussed
- One uncontroversial suggestions for change:
 - Section on use descriptors should be extended with life cycle stage





- Background documents are an important element in SPERC documentation / justification
- Few examples exist to date
- Expectations
 - Development of background documents per se can be a significant effort.
 - Existing information (BREFs, etc.) can be leveraged.
- What is needed? Common Understanding
 - Degree of detail, confidential information for justification etc.
 - ECHA, national authorities and industry



Taking SPERCs to Next Level Two Workstreams




- Factsheets
