

Objectives:

 Improving functioning of the internal market and use of biocides

 Ensuring high level of protection for human & animal health and the environment

  - Support to the Biocidal Products Committee
  - How to handle substance sameness
  - Dissemination of public information
  - Manage and maintain IT-tools
  - Guidance and support
