What is the ESCom Package?




• ESCom XML standard:

- An IT communication standard to harmonize ES data exchange between computer systems in the supply chain
- Developed by IT providers in consultation with industry

• ESCom Phrase Catalogue:

- A catalogue with standard phrases for ESs for communication
- Developed by industry sectors, associations and companies



Main benefits of the ESCom Package



- Avoids manual handling; reduces resources needed for communication of ES in the supply chain
- Increases consistency in the supply chain communication by using standard phrases
- Allows efficient processing of ES information at company level
- Facilitates translation of ES
- Reduces likelihood of misinterpretation of ES information in the supply chain
- Contributes to meeting the requirements of REACH

Current status of the ESCom Package



• ESCom XML Standard:

- ESCom XML version 1.1 released in October 2011
- An updated ESCom XML version 2 (Chesar compatible) has been developed; will be made available free of charge (based on an XML User Licence) by end of 2013

• ESCom Phrase Catalogue:

- Has been updated and released in March 2013 (version 1.1)
- Can be downloaded from the Cefic website, next to a Chesar import file (enables import of all phrases into Chesar 2.2)
- Features:
 - o Contains over 1900 standard phrases
 - Fully aligned with EuPhraC ES phrases (identical phrase ID)
 - o Metadata assigned to phrases to enhance searching
 - o Includes phrases for all currently available SPERCs
 - Includes all "plugged-in" phrases for assessment with CHESAR

Sustainability of the ESCom Package



Requirements to succesfully sustain the ESCom Package in the years to come

- ESCom XML: IT providers
 - Agreement on IP rights and licensing IP rights for all IT providers contributing to the development of ESCom XML
 - Alignment with ECHA (Chesar XML)
- ESCom Phrase Catalogue: Chemical industry
 - Phrase team resourced with industry experts
 - Financial resources for maintaining ESCom Phrase Catalogue
 - Further implementation of phrase management work processes
 - Administrative support for phrase management work
- Interface XML Phrase Catalogue: liaison IT providers and industry
 - Agreement with IT providers on licencing IP rights for industry
 - Future modifications that may impact XML structure and/or Catalogue structure/content

ESCom Package: building for the future



Securing the ESCom Package for 2013 – 2015:

- Memorandum of Understanding between the main parties to continue the development and maintainance of the ESCom Package as a minimum until end 2015
- Exposure Scenario Collaboration Working Agreement between IT providers (arranges further development of ESCom XML, including IP rights and licensing of IP rights to industry)
- License Agreement for industry organisations to enable publication/use of ESCom XML by industry
- Establishing a Project organisation for the ESCom Package

Timing for completion: June 2013

Project organisation ESCom Package



- Aim of the project:
 - Maintain the ESCom Phrase Catalogue
 - Liaise with IT providers regarding development and availability of ESCom XML
 - Promotion and communication of project deliverables
 - (Development /maintenance of ESCom XML: responsibility of IT providers)
- Project partners/stakeholders: Cefic, DUCC, IT providers, ECHA, BDI
- ESCom Steering Committee:
 - Overseeing the full project (progress, budgetting, communication)
 - Ensuring sufficient resources and support for the ESCom Phrases Working Group (maintaining the Phrase Catalogue)
 - Communication with ESCom stakeholders

Maintaining the Phrase Catalogue: next steps

- Re-establishing the ESCOM Phrases Working Group:
 - Additional resourcing of the phrase group with industry experts, ensuring balanced representation
 - Review and improve current workprocess for phrase management (including system for phrase management and cooperation with contractor for administrative support)
 - Review and improve current rules for phrase approval/rejection
 - Review and agree on Guidance for standard phrases (with EuPhraC)
- Selection of contractor for administrative support
 - System/database for phrase management
 - Administrative management of the phrase catalogue

Timing for completion: August 2013 System fully operational: September 2013

Deliverables next release Phrase Catalogue

- Fully updated according to the new rules for approval/rejection and the Guidance for standard phrases (structure)
- All phrase submissions by companies/sector organisations reviewed and processed
- Inclusion of phrases for all SPERC/SCEDs available at that point in time
- Ensuring continuation of alignment with the Chesar tool
- Additional standard phrases to facilitate the generation of systematic short titles (Table of Contents: refer to presentation by S. Lemoine)
