Use of textile articles containing polymer dispersion	Service-life, fabric, textiles and apparels (AC5)
Use of Flexible Elastomeric Foam (FEF) articles	Service-life, flexible elastomer foam articles (FEF)*

Reasons for differentiation

Release/exposure patterns driven by

- Type of article and corresponding use conditions
 - HIPS articles can warm up during use
 - Particulate emission during cutting of EPS and XPS insulation material (workers activity)
- Type of article and corresponding emission factors
 - emission factor from polymer foam (EPS/XPS) much higher than solid polymer (HIPS)

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Conclusions

- Example supports the harmonisation proposal but:
 - Life cycle stage : need for further differentiation of service life?
 - Article type: need for flexibility regarding the level of detail required for describing the article
 - 3rd identifier needed: dust generating process (for e.g. cutting)
- It shows that existing category system may not be suitable (TARIC), so creation of new categories and corresponding standard phrases under ESCom may be needed.

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
