Do I need IUCLID 5?







Do I need IUCLID 5?

- You will need IUCLID 5 if you are an/a:
 - IMPORTER
 - MANUFACTURER
 - (DOWNSTREAM USER <u>only</u> if uses not covered by manufacturer)
 - ONLY REPRESENTATIVE
- You do not need IUCLID 5 if you are a:
 - REIMPORTER
 - RECYCLER
 - DOWNSTREAM USER



What is IUCLID 5 about?







What is IUCLID 5?

- is an IT application built to enter, store and report information on chemicals
- has been developed for REACH and other chemical legislation programmes (e.g. OECD HPV and EU Biocides)
- is the tool for industry to fulfill their REACH requirements (legal obligations).
- is the "scientific" database repository in the Agency both for Agency staff and MS-CA

- Distributed Version
 - For IT-Expert to install
 - Installation manuals are available on the IUCLID website for:
 - Windows environment
 - Linux environment




- Stand alone:








How do I install IUCLID?


