SME definition and benefits





What is an SME?

 SME means a micro, small or medium-sized enterprise within the meaning of <u>Commission Recommendation</u> <u>2003/361/EC</u>

Enterprise category	Headcount	Turnover or Balance sheet total	
Medium-sized	< 250	≤ € 50 million	≤ € 43 million
Small	< 50	≤ € 10 million	≤ € 10 million
Micro	< 10	≤ € 2 million	≤ € 2 million

^{*} Remember that all partners and linked enterprises should be considered in order to meet the thresholds

Benefits for SMEs under REACH

 SMEs benefit from fee reductions, depending on their size

SME fee reduction up to 95%

How does it work?





Practical steps

- Get familiar with the provisions of the Commission Recommendation 2003/361/EC and the new SME definition -User guide and model declaration
- Collect all the documents needed to establish the company size
- Assess and declare your size correctly at the time of each submission
- Enterprises declare their size at the registration stage
 NB: The Only Representatives should declare the size of the non-EU manufacturer that they represent and NOT that of their own.
