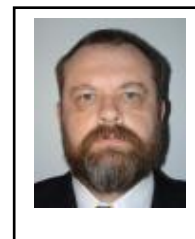

Chemicals regulation	I joined HSE in 1995, as a Regulatory Scientist assessing the human health effects of industrial chemicals under the Existing Substance Regulation (ESR) and providing expert scientific advice to HSE and industry in relation to the regulation of industrial chemicals under the Notification of New Substances Scheme.
REACH	Between April 2007 – March 2009 I worked in HSE's REACH team raising awareness within industry and government agencies of the requirements and obligations of REACH. I also wrote a number of guidance documents dealing with specific parts of the REACH legislation which were intended for use by UK manufacturers / importers.
Biocides	Between April 2009 and March 2016 I worked on the Biocides helpdesk of HSE's Chemicals Regulation Division (CRD) as a regulatory specialist providing expert advice to HSE and industry on the regulatory requirements relating to biocidal products. I was also the designated UK representative attending meetings of EU Member States' biocides helpdesks (HelpNet) hosted by the European Chemicals Agency.
