THE EXCHANGE NETWORK IS THERE TO:

- **Better understand your challenges in building and communicating ESs**
 - **Much already achieved and available to prepare ESs e.g. use descriptor system**
 - **Significant task but doable, provided:**
 - **Start early. Must ACT NOW! REACH 2013**
 - **Avoid late changes: wastes resource, delays the CSR, affects the "quality"**
 - **Frustrations / Disappointment in the operation of SIEFs in respect of ES: set clear roles & expectations**
 - **Consortia now concluded after first phase registration; less Consortia expected for next deadline**
 - **Communicate ES through the supply chain**

THE EXCHANGE NETWORK IS THERE TO:

- **Promote cooperation**
 - **Your participation demonstrates this!**
 - **Shared what your doing:**
 - **Presentations & 9 marketplaces – approaches adaptable by others**
 - **How tackling complexities in supply chain communication**
 - **Capitalise on these real, practical experiences**
 - **You can follow up on what's been developed and been exchanged**

THE EXCHANGE NETWORK IS THERE TO:

- **Promote clear and consistent information in ESs**
 - **This is the goal!**
 - **Are we there yet?**
 - **Message: Much achieved but still learning**
 - **Proof will be effective risk management measures at all levels in the supply chain**
 - **How to promote that ES are well done in practice**
 - **How can we (*the REACH actors*) measure reaching our goal?**

THE EXCHANGE NETWORK IS THERE TO:

- **Provide and obtain feedback on their quality**
 - **ECHA will continue to do e.g. Evaluation *Progress Report 2011***
 - **Feedback from downstream users just beginning:**
 - ***Quality* of ES reflects extent of supplier/DU dialogue? Meets expectations?**
