BH/mk**NOTE****Subject: PUBLICATION OF THE LIST OF NOMINEES FOR THE COMMITTEE FOR SOCIO-ECONOMIC ANALYSIS**

In accordance with Article 85(1) of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the Council (REACH Regulation), each Member State may nominate candidates to membership of the Socio-economic Analysis Committee. The Executive Director shall establish a list of the nominees, which shall be published on the European Chemicals Agency's (ECHA) website. The Management Board shall appoint the members of the Committee from this list, including at least one member but not more than two from the nominees of each Member State. Members shall be appointed for their role and experience in performing the tasks specified in Article 77(3).

In accordance with Article 85(4) of the REACH Regulation, the membership of the Committee members appointed for a term of three years shall be renewable.

Responding to the letter sent to the Member States Permanent Representations (dated 2 October 2020); two Member States have nominated the following new candidates for SEAC membership.
