Key Messages – Co-Registrants Page

- More transparency: timely and detailed information
 - See everyone who registered your substance
 - Only access to substance for which your LE has a reference number
 - Helps comply with own data sharing and joint submission obligations : Read middle section
- You need to:
 - Check your contact details: own LE or TPR – latest submission
 - Ensure you are part of the joint submission

[-] Joint submission and data sharing obligations

Joint submission obligation

ECHA reminds you that, pursuant to Articles 11 and 19 of the REACH Regulation (which apply for this substance) only one joint registration shall be submitted for this substance. Therefore all registrants share a common duty to submit a joint registration dossier.

- if a registration of the same substance has been submitted by one or more other registrants, you are required to form a joint submission with them.
- if no registration has been submitted yet, you must agree with all potential registrants on a "lead" registrant. The "lead" registrant shall first submit the information specified in Article 11(1)(2) of the REACH Regulation on behalf of the others (the lead registrant). Each registrant shall subsequently submit the information specified in Article 11(1)(3) of the REACH Regulation.

Please note that failure to comply with your joint submission obligation will amount to a breach of the REACH Regulation, and you may be subject to further legal consequences as provided in applicable national laws.

Data sharing obligation

Under Articles 27 and 30 of the REACH Regulation, you are obliged to request information involving tests on vertebrate animals, required for your registration, from the previous registrants of the same substance or SIEF participants. You may request information not involving tests on vertebrate animals. The potential registrants and the previous registrants of the same substance or SIEF members shall make every effort to reach a fair, transparent and non-discriminatory agreement on the sharing of existing information and the associated costs.

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Key Features – Potential registrants

- Only after successful Article 26 inquiry
- Only the LR role of registrants & only 12 months
- View inquiry result via the annotation of the Search function (not only via message box)
- Dynamic tool : annotations up-to-date (versus communication once at the time of processing)

Key Features – Registrants


- After successful Registration
- After claiming a substance notified under Dir 548/67/EEC
- All roles: LR, member, other
- View information requirements (.pdf document)
- Dynamic tool: always last update displayed
 - Article 12(2) inquiry

Last minute

- Access to Co-Registrants Page
 - As of functionality available
 - No Need to submit an inquiry
- No processing of inquiries
 - 16 November 2012– 30 November 2012
- Down-time REACH-IT
 - 28 November 2012 noon – 30 November 2012 noon
