CLARIFICATIONS 30

30.1 Q: 25.1 On page 25 it is said that tenders must include “a statement from the same agent confirming the validity of the tender”. What kind of statement is needed as a proof of this?

A: The tender must include a declaration to be provided in free format and to be signed by an authorized agent, which states that the tender is valid.

What is meant by an authorized agent? Does it refer to company’s person with the legal rights for signing the Tender?

If the Tender is a joint offer, does the statement need signatures from all group members?

The authorized agent is to be the same one who signs the legal entity form. The Legal Entity Form is to be signed by a representative of the tenderer authorised to sign contracts with third parties.

In case of a joint offer, the tender must be signed by the authorized agent of the entity designated by the other entities involved in the bid to act as the Group Leader.
