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Amending budget 2011

(Document adopted by the Management Board)

1. Background of the first amending budget 2011

There are two reasons calling for amending the Agency's 2011 budget.

Firstly, the article 16 of ECHA's Financial Regulation states that

“If the balance of the outturn account within the meaning of Article 81 is positive, it shall be repaid to the Commission up to the amount of the Community subsidy paid during the year. The part of the balance exceeding the amount of the Community subsidy paid during the year shall be entered in the budget for the following year as revenue.”

As ECHA has finalised its 2010 accounts and repaid its temporary subsidy of €36 million back to the Commission, the remaining balance of the budgetary outturn account is now to be entered to the budget as revenue.

Secondly, as referred to in agenda point 7 of the present meeting, ECHA expects soon to receive a contribution from the European Commission to finance the necessary preparatory activities for the upcoming Biocides Regulation. This amount must also be included in the 2011 budget.

In line with the article 28 of ECHA's Financial Regulation that states

“Any amendment to the budget, including the establishment plan, shall be the subject of an amending budget adopted by the same procedure as the initial budget, in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and Article 27 of this Regulation”,

the Management Board is invited to adopt the following amendments to ECHA's 2011 budget resulting in a net increase by € 216.2 million of the budget total:

a) Income

- i) Title 1 – Revenue from fees and charges (article 199): Entry of the positive balance from the budget outturn account of the Financial Year 2010 totalling €280,565,807.25 and resulting from fees and charges collected until 31 December 2010, payable pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006.
- ii) Title 1 – Revenue from fees and charges (article 100): Entry of the actual amount collected this year until 31 May 2011 from fees and charges totalling € 17,200,000, payable pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 and update of the estimation for the remainder of the year by € 14,000,000. This total amount of € 31,200,000 replaces thus the initial fee revenue amount that had initially been entered to balance the budget before the 2010 accounts were finalised.
- iii) Title 2 – European Union contributions (article 203): introduction of earmarked revenue amounting to €500,000 for 2011 according to Service contract ENV.D.3/SER/2011/552228 to be signed between ECHA and the DG Environment of the European Commission. These funds are intended to cover the cost of preparatory activities before the entry into force of the upcoming Biocides Regulation.

b) Expenditure

i) Title 4 – Operating Expenditure - Biocides: increase by € 0.5 million

These funds are intended to cover the costs of the preparatory activities before the entry into force of the upcoming Biocides Regulation as described in the document MB/01/2011 produced for the March 2011 Management Board meeting. The main areas of expenditure are the analysis of the IT systems including the Register for the Biocidal products and IUCLID, the development of the administrative procedures and systems as well as the development of the technical guidance documents required to support the implementation of the proposed Regulation. Part of the appropriations will be used for the development of the staff plan, including the selection and the training plan.

ii) Title 9 – Other expenditure - Reserve: increase by € 215.7 million

The amount under this Title is not intended to be used directly for commitments and payments of expenditure but instead will serve as a reserve. This reserve budget item will be cleared annually against the actual implementation of the expenditure until it is used up.
