  - National stakeholder workshop of actors involved in preparation of restrictions proposals and applications for authorisation

- 2. What are main obstacles in the preparation of a meaningful
  - a. application for authorisation?
  - b. restriction proposal?
- 3. What is needed to overcome the identified obstacles to improve the preparation of the necessary documents? Who needs to contribute to the process? What are information needs?
- 4. With reference to the RMOA process, what can be the stakeholders commitment to support opinion making (in general and specifically of your organisation)?
