Dr Katrin Schütte is a policy officer at the EU Commission's Directorate for the Environment, which she joined in 2014.

Katrin has a degree in nutrition sciences from the University of Hohenheim, a PhD in neurobiology from the University of Heidelberg and is a Diplomate of the American Board of Toxicology (DABT) and European Registered Toxicologist (ERT).

Before joining the Commission, she worked for 15 years as a toxicologist and regulatory affairs manager at Procter & Gamble in the consumer products sector. Her responsibilities in the Commission cover the REACH regulation chapters Registration and Evaluation as well as the Directive 2010/63/EU on the protection of animals used for scientific purposes. She has participated in the elaboration of the 2018 REACH Evaluation Report, several implementing regulations under REACH and some Commission decisions on Evaluation. She is also involved in the review activities of the Commission for low tonnage substances and polymers according to Article 138.

She is a member of the steering committee of EPAA (European Partnership for Alternative Approaches to Animal testing) and co-leader of the EPAA project team on Harmonization of Three Rs in Biological products.
