


Annex	Issue	Aim of the Annex
I	Substance/ composition identity	Identify what is being applied for
II	Intended use	<ul> <li>Describe the use in a comprehensive manner</li> <li>Explain relevant past assessments</li> </ul>
III	Physico-chemical properties	<ul> <li>Supporting data to understand reactions and health hazards</li> </ul>
IV	Migration and identification of relevant chemical species	<ul> <li>How to test for migration</li> <li>Collect information on migration analytical methods</li> <li>Generate concentrations at the tap (Ctap)</li> <li>Conclude on the identification of the relevant chemical species</li> </ul>
V	Toxicological assessment of relevant chemicals species	<ul> <li>Determine toxicological properties of relevant chemical species, depending on migration level of each one</li> <li>Support risk assessment under Annex VI</li> </ul>
VI	Risk acceptance	<ul> <li>Determine MTC<sub>tap</sub> for each relevant chemical species</li> <li>Ensure C<sub>tap</sub> &lt; MTC<sub>tap</sub> for each relevant chemical species</li> </ul>


### **DWD** Business process








### Notification of intention to apply end to end solution

## Update on DWD application IUCLID format & validation rules




#### Dossier specific information in the dossier header

- → Type of application
- → Material type
- → Is it a group entry? (EUPL number of the group entry, scope of the group entry application)
- → Is the applicant a competent relevant authority? → Application justified by urgency without prior submission of notification of intention → Justification for urgency
- → Migration tier for the applied-for entry
- → Remarks
- → Submission is an update → only further to request/decision from a regulatory body and with the confirmation that the updated submission is final



#### Validation areas for Applications

- → Substance identity under sections 1.1\_Identification, 1.2\_Composition
  - Example: BR\_DWD\_001 A reference substance must be linked in section 1.1
- Material type alignment with the relevant documents in the dossier/dataset
  - Example: BR\_DWD\_008 'Material type' under the Dossier header must be aligned with all 'Material type' entries in the dossier
- → Study information requirement
  - BR\_DWD\_014 under the Appearance/state of the substance a key study, weight of evidence or data waiver must be provided

  - Intended use of the applied-for entry (4)
  - Data on migration of the substance (5.1)
  - Data on electrochemical test and passivation tendency of metallic material (5.2)
  - Risk acceptance (8)
  - Assessment by other authorities (9)




### Validation checks for Applications


- → The due date for the feedback on validation of a DWD application end of Aug 2024
- → Target release October 2025

## **DWD** application & CBI



### CBI in Commission Delegated Regulation 2024/369

- → Article 10(2): the following shall be considered confidential and may not be made publicly available:
  - a. identification of an applicant in case of a designated representative;
  - **b.** manufacturing process of substance and process of its use;
  - c. any link between any operators in the same supply chain
  - d. information received from another Union body, agency or a Member State, for which confidentiality has been granted by the body that provided this information to ECHA;
  - e. an impurity, unless that impurity is a relevant chemical species.
- → CBI aspects yet to be addressed fully in the IUCLID format

#### Understanding the Drinking Water Directive

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CONSULTATIONS

The Drinking Water Directive (DWD) aims to protect people and the environment from the harmful effects of contaminated drinking water and to improve access to drinking water. It came into force on 12 January 2021 following a review of the original Drinking Water Directive of 1998.

The directive introduces minimum requirements for materials that are in contact with water meant for human consumption throughout the EU. Harmonising these requirements ensures protection of people in the EU and improves the functioning of the internal market.

Article 11 of the revised directive sets out the framework for minimum hygiene requirements for materials in contact with drinking water. This framework was legally adopted by the European Commission as six legal acts, which were published on 23 April 2024.

The DWD IT user group has been set up by ECHA to help in developing the IT tools authorities will use to prepare and submit DWD dossiers from the end of 2025.
