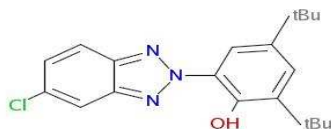

Germany presented a proposal in accordance with Article 59(3) and Annex XV of the Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 (REACH Regulation) (26 February 2013, submission number DD016889-41) on identification of *2,4-di-tert-butyl-6-(5-chlorobenzotriazol-2-yl)phenol (UV-327)* as a substance of very high concern due to its very persistent and very bioaccumulative (vPvB) properties.

Pursuant to Article 59(3) and 59(4) REACH the Annex XV dossier was circulated to other Member States on 4 March 2013 and the Annex XV report was made available to interested parties on the ECHA website on the same day.

Comments on the proposal were received from both Member States and interested parties.

The dossier was referred to the Member State Committee on 21 May 2013 and was discussed in the meeting on 11-14 June 2013 of the Member State Committee.

Agreement of the Member State Committee in accordance with Article 59(8):

It is considered that it is currently not possible to conclude on the identification of *2,4-di-tert-butyl-6-(5-chlorobenzotriazol-2-yl)phenol (UV-327)* as a substance of very high concern in accordance with Article 57 (e) of REACH Regulation .

UNDERLYING ARGUMENTATION FOR THE DECISION TAKEN

Due to the need for further consideration of the documentation provided by the dossier submitter during the meeting, the Member State Committee agreed that it is currently not possible to conclude on the identification of *2,4-di-tert-butyl-6-(5-chlorobenzotriazol-2-yl)phenol (UV-327)* as a substance of very high concern.
