Formulation Type:	Green solid bait block in a tamper resistant bait box.		
Statement of use:	Fast Action Mouse Killer is a single use tamper resistant bait box containing 2 Alphachloralose (4% w/w) bait blocks, only for the control of mice by non-professionals users indoors only. Bait box is for single use only, ready and easy to use. Do not open bait box. Do not use in areas where food for human consumption or feed for livestock is prepared, consumed or stored. Simply place the bait box where mice have been seen. Ideal locations are against walls, under cupboards or behind furniture (where they cannot be tampered with). Bait boxes must be placed in areas inaccessible to children, companion animals and non-target animals. Where possible, secure bait box at its placement site so that it cannot be dragged away by mice and to minimise the risk of consumption and poisoning to children, companion animals and other non-target animals. When using more than one bait box, place them 3 metres apart. To maximise the bait take, ensure that alternative food sources have been removed wherever possible. Bait boxes should only be placed for a maximum of 7-10 days. Search for and remove dead mice regularly throughout the 7-10 day treatment operation to minimise the risk of consumption and		

	Dead mice should be double-bagged using plastic bags and either disposed of in a household waste bin with a secure lid to prevent access of wildlife or pets and collected in accordance with local requirements, as appropriate. Once the mice population is controlled do not place further bait box down until a new infestation is identified. In some unusual situations, if mice activity remains, it may be necessary to try another means of control or consult a professional pest controller. Remove all bait boxes after treatment and dispose of in accordance with local requirements. Bait boxes must not be reused or recycled. Wash hands after use of the product, and before eating, drinking or smoking. If swallowed, seek medical

Pack sizes and packaging material	Fast Action Mouse Killer will be supplied in an outer cardboard box containing up to 4 tamper resistant bait boxes, made up of polypropylene. Each tamper resistant bait box will contain 2 x 5g bait blocks. Pack size 10g.

This authorisation may be subject to review in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 528/2012, as amended by Regulation (EU) No 334/2014, or the European Union (Biocidal Products) Regulations, 2013, (S.I. 427 of 2013). The outcome of such a review may lead to amendments to or the revocation of this authorisation.

The following conditions and restrictions apply:

- 1. Product may **not** be made available on the market or used in the Republic of Ireland unless it complies with the Annexes of this authorisation.
- 2. The requirements and conditions, specified in the Annexes, of this authorisation may **not** be altered without prior approval of modifications by the Irish Competent Authority for Biocides in Ireland. Where any amendments are made to the original authorisation in another Member State, the Irish Competent Authority for Biocides in Ireland must be informed by the Authorisation Holder.
- 3. The holder of this certificate for authorisation must inform or provide the Irish Competent Authority for Biocides with any new or requested information/data, respectively, that shows this biocidal product and/or any of its active substances cause or may cause an adverse effect on human or animal health, ground water or the environment.
- 4. All product made available on the market in Ireland must comply with the classification, labelling and packaging requirements established in: Article 69 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012; the Chemicals Act 2008 (as amended) transposing Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008; and the classification, labelling and Safety Data Sheet information detailed in the Annex II to this certificate.
- 5. All biocidal products advertised must comply with Article 72 of Regulation (EU) No 528/2012.
- 6. A printed copy of the Irish label in accordance with the Annexes of this authorisation must be submitted to the Irish Competent Authority for Biocides prior to any product being made available on the market in Ireland. All product labels must carry the authorisation number of the form: IE/BPA 70095.
- 7. Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for the biocidal product(s) shall be prepared and made available in accordance with Article 70 of the Biocidal Products Regulation 528/2012 (as amended). Relevant sections of the SDS must be updated post-authorisation in accordance with Annex II of the authorisation certificate. In particular, Section 15 of the SDS should be updated to contain the authorisation number IE/BPA 70095. The SDS must be submitted to the Irish Competent Authority for Biocides and the National Poisons Information Centre of Ireland http://www.poisons.ie/manufacturers.asp before the product is made available on the market for sale or use.
- 8. On an annual basis, details of the quantities of this product (by pack size) manufactured in Ireland, imported into Ireland and/or exported from Ireland must be submitted to the Irish Competent Authority for Biocides by 31 January of the following year.
- 9. Fees are payable for the maintenance of the product on the Register of Biocidal Products and shall be paid by the 31st December of the following year and each year thereafter.
