## Extended expiry date for 2022 ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE FR SAS – Racumin Expert – NO-2021-0216

With reference to the document CA-Sept14-Doc.5.7 –Final regarding expiry dates of biocidal product authorisations, and concerning the expiry date for the biocidal product Racumin Expert, NO-2021-0216.

### Decision

The Norwegian Environment Agency hereby grants 2022 ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE FR SAS a postponement of the expiry date for the authorisation for the biocidal product Racumin Expert on the Norwegian market. The expiry date is postponed from 26 February 2024 to 1 July 2024.

The product is mutual recognised in Norway under the terms and conditions as described in the final Norwegian Summary Product Characteristic (SPC) attached to the R4BP3 asset case no. NO-0027303-0000. The final SPC can also be found on the website of the European Chemicals Agency here: [Information on biocides - ECHA \(europa.eu\)](https://echa.europa.eu/information-on-biocides).

The grant of extension of expiry date is given in accordance with Article 5 of Regulation (EU) No 492/2014 (renewal of authorisations of biocidal products).

### Background

Regulation (EU) No. 528/2012 (the Biocidal Products Regulation, BPR), is implemented in Norwegian law through the Norwegian Biocide Regulation of 18 April 2017 No. 480.

The reference Member State for the renewal of the biocidal product, Germany, have extended the authorisation for Racumin Expert until 1 July 2024. For authorisations that are mutual recognised, it is agreed among the Member States that these authorisations shall have the same expiry date as the national authorisation granted by the reference Member State (c.f. CA-Sept14-Doc.5.7 –Final).

The current expiry date for the Norwegian authorisation is 26 February 2024.

## Evaluation by the Norwegian Environment Agency

This decision is based on the evaluation of the reference Member State.

## Right to appeal

This decision may be appealed to the Ministry of Climate and Environment.

An appeal shall be submitted to the Norwegian Environment Agency within three weeks after receipt of this letter.
