On extension of authorisation for Creosote_EN_13991_BPF

Latvian Environment, Geology and Meteorology Centre (LEGMC) would like to inform on extension of the expiry date of national authorisation granted through mutual recognition for the **Creosote_EN_13991_BPF** (authorisation number **LV/2017/MR/015**).

Rain Carbon Germany GmbH on 27 February 2020 submitted an application for renewal of a national authorisation in accordance with Article 31(1) of *Regulation (EU) No 5285/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 May 2012 concerning the making available on the market and use of biocidal products* for **Creosote_EN_13991_BPF**. The application under the Case No BC-XE057588-18 in R4BP3 will be evaluated after relevant decision on renewal of a national authorisation will be made by Reference Member State (rMS) – Sweden.

However, taking into account *Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2020/1038 of 15 July 2020 postponing the expiry date of approval of creosote for use in biocidal products of product-type 8* and agreement between Member States to prolong the authorisations of products containing creosote, to allow that the renewal of these products takes place after the approval of the active substance¹, LEGMC would like to inform that the authorisation for **Creosote_EN_13991_BPF** is extended and authorisation number **LV/2017/MR/015** is valid until **29 March 2024**, according to rMS decision.

LEGMC would like to ask **Rain Carbon Germany GmbH** to notify the above-mentioned information down to supply chain.
